
& Summer Days Are Here Again &

the rest of the year. It has been and still is a terrible pandemic!







PARADE SEASON AND HEAT-RELATED ISSUES

Good day Ladies and Nobles. I would like to take a moment of your time to discuss heat related issues during parade season. We are currently in our lovely monsoon season in Colorado,

but that as we all know will end soon. With that being said, the temperature is rising, and the humidity is dropping. Often when we travel to different events across the state, we start our day before sun up and may be out till almost sun down. The constant exposure to sun and heat can be a deadly combination.

There are three types of heat illness/injuries. In the order of least serious to most sever are heat cramps, heat exhaustion, and heat stroke. If these conditions go untreated serious medical conditions could arise.

Heat cramps are just that, cramps. Sudden cramps, most often in the larger muscle groups that may feel like the middle of the night charley horse that won't go away. The cramps may also be accompanied with tremor activity.

The next is heat exhaustion. This is a result of your body overheating. Heat exhaustion is your bodies attempt to

compensate for the environmental conditions. Often presents with heavy sweating and increased pulse rate.

The last condition is the most serious, heat stroke. Heat stroke occurs when the body in no longer able to control its temperature. Sweating stops and the individual becomes hot to

the touch. Once the body's ability to compensate is shut down the internal body temperature can rise upwards to 106 degrees Fahrenheit in less than twenty minutes.

The things we need to watch for, not only on ourselves but those around us, are the common signs of heat related illness and injuries. These signs include headache, nausea, dizziness, weakness, thirst, heavy sweating, and hot to touch.

Other than avoiding hot temperatures the ways to help prevent these issues are simple. First

HYDRATE, HYDRATE, HYDRATE. Drink water, not sugar filled soft drinks. The loss of water and electrolytes is the main contributor to heat related injuries and illnesses. Gatorade and Pedialyte are great for electrolyte replacement but try to drink zero sugar or mix 50% sports drink to 50% water. Remember the water you drink the night before is what is going to be in your system first thing in the morning. Hydration is a constant process. Alcohol is one of the worst things to drink prior to an event or out in the weather. Next wear loose fitting and lightweight clothes that are breathable and designed for sun protection and hot weather. Large hats to keep the sun off the face and head. These help prevent immediate evaporation of sweat and allows it to do its job of cooling the skin. Next is get out of the heat when at all possible. Short breaks in air conditioning allows the body to cool without stressing its compensation mechanisms. Cheat to win so to speak. Then finally if you start to feel bad let someone know. Steps can be taken to prevent serious incidents.

I hope to see everyone having fun at the summer events. As always everyone, have a great day and be safe.


