- RESOLUTION:
- Whereas, revenue from Al Kaly Shrine dues is far short of meeting requirements to fund the administrative affairs and,
- Whereas, membership continues to decline reducing our dues income and,
- Whereas, to the extent Al Kaly Shrine is projecting a reduction in membership which could be in excess of fifty members for 2020 and,
- Now, therefore, be it resolved that an increase in Al Kaly dues from \$65.00 to \$75.00 will create an additional \$3,000 in revenue to help offset our budget deficits.

The membership voted to sell Raffle calendars with a reduced commission of only \$5.00 and top payout of \$500 instead of \$1,000. There was a motion from the floor by I.S. Potter and a second and passed. The Recorder reminded the nobility the raffle calendar is a unit fundraiser, the Temple makes very little money after admin expenses are computed. Also, if it is not profitable the Temple is responsible for the payout of \$15,000. I.S. Palmer recommended eliminating the unit commission and the nobility was not in favor. I.S. Potter stated this is a good fundraiser for the units.
