SYMBOLISM OF FEZ, EMBLEM & CEREMONIAL

First Ceremonial Master

The red Fez hat, our official headgear, is prominently marked by emblem of the Shrine – consisting of the Scimitar, Crescent and Star. The Crescent is composed of two Royal Bengal Tiger Claws united in a gold setting by a Keystone. This is a Masonic reference to the Keystone of Royal Arch Masonry uniting the tiger claws to form not only a Crescent, but an Arch, as well.

Inside the Keystone, on the keystone's face, is the head of the Sphinx. Behind the Crescent hangs the Star of Bethlehem. Depicted above the Crescent is a Scimitar, from which the Crescent and Star are suspended. The Star of Bethlehem is a clear reference to the "Star of the East" observed at the time of the birth of Jesus Christ. The 5-pointed Star is of significant influence to those men in the Commandery of the Knights Templar.

Over the years, the Crescent has been connected to the Scimitar in many, creative ways. One of these include two cables, symbolic of our Masonic Cable-Tow. The two principle ties being used were a direct reference to the two Rites (Scottish Rite and York Rite). These were formerly prerequisites for obtaining and retaining Shrine membership. Also, the cables probably have another triple significance: 1) referring to the rope used in conjunction with the LEWIS- a crimping device to raise heavy stones easier; 2) to the ropes significant to Royal Arch Masonry; and 3) to the Cable-Tow itself, pertaining to Ancient Craft Masonry, which binds us, guides us, and governs our sense of duty to ourselves.

In the York Rite, the Knights Templar wear chapeaus, whereas in the Scottish Rite, a cap is worn. Yet, the Shrine Fez, with the bright red color is adorned by a sharp black tassel, conjures-up romantic images of the "Arabian Nights." Although inspired by ceremonies which may have originated in the Muslim world, the Shrine simply borrows insights from diverse places and cultures into the solemn and honorable ritualistic ceremonies we see today. From the History of the Shrine, the ceremonial is alleged to be Bektash, a Sufi dervish order, in origin. Nevertheless, it encourages each member to hold fast to his own faith to worship Almighty God in whatever manner he chooses without interference. Therefore, the Shrine honors men of all faiths. Over the years, millions of men from Judeo-Christian backgrounds have felt at ease with the purpose and mission of the Shrine.
