Helping children is first and foremost among Al Kaly Shriners and Shriners Hospitals and Clinics across North America.


The mission of Shriners Hospitals is to:

# FEATURED SHRINER JAY BERNARD

Jay met Barbara at a Singles Group Halloween Party in 1978, at the Minnequa Club. He knew two of her female cousins and liked them so he thought Barb would be a nice lady to get to know. It was a week or so later that they were at the To It Club with other friends when they really connected. He pretty much believes fate or a guardian angel was working on them that night – they haven't been apart since.

Jay's hobbies include collecting light bulbs! He also has a large collection of tools that he used in his work. He enjoys "messing" with his light bulbs and light fixtures. He also enjoys watching TV and videos. Jay and Barb's other interests do differ a bit. She likes to travel, he likes to stay home. She does needlework, he fiddles with his electrical stuff. Their common interests are being home together and spending time with their family. They have two children. Daughter Kathryn (Katie) Rael and her husband Chris and their son Xavier, who is their only grandchild; they have spent the





# EAST-WEST SHRINE BOWL COLLEGE FOOTBALL ALL-STAR GAME HEADS TO LAS VEGAS IN 2022

NEW YORK (July 6, 2021) – The East-West Shrine Bowl<sup>TM</sup>, America's longest-running college football all-star game, which supports Shriners Hospitals for Children®, will be played on Feb. 3, 2022, at the home of the Las Vegas Raiders as part of NFL Pro Bowl week.

Televised nationally during primetime on NFL Network, the East-West

Shrine Bowl will kick off from Allegiant Stadium, one of the nation's premier professional stadiums. The Thursday evening event will bring approximately 125 of the nation's top college seniors to be coached by NFL staffs for a week of preparation in front of hundreds of NFL scouts, professional agents and media, all leading up to the 2022 NFL Draft, which will also be held in Las Vegas.



"The East-West Shrine Bowl is

exemplary of the values of football, as all involved have the opportunity to inspire and encourage the children and families at Shriners Hospitals," said Troy Vincent, NFL executive vice president of football operations. "In addition to community service and engagement, student athletes get an early start on the evaluation of their skills and coaches also showcase their talent, develop professionally, and network with colleagues, which is invaluable to the future of football."

Throughout the 97-year storied history of the East-West Shrine Bowl, the legendary game has produced more than 500 NFL Pro Bowl appearances. The 2022 game will mark the first time that both the Shrine Bowl and Pro Bowl align during the same week to strengthen the relationship between the two events. The move to Las Vegas this February comes after the Shrine Bowl was played in St. Petersburg, Florida, for the past 10 years.

"This is a historic day for the East-West Shrine Bowl and Shriners Hospitals for Children," said Bob Roller, director of national sports management for Shriners Hospitals. "Our goal was to expand the reach and mission of our healthcare system and to hold a world-class sporting event, and this partnership with the NFL and Pro Bowl Week greatly enhances

our on-going mission that has helped more than 1.5 million children since opening in 1922."


