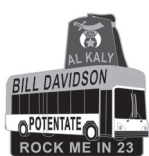
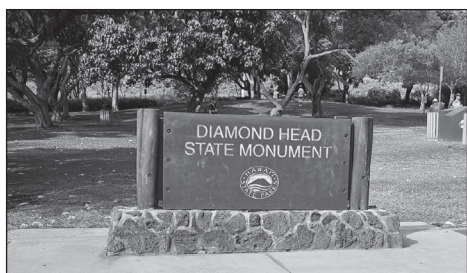

December 8, 2023 at 7 p.m.
Pueblo Masonic Center
126 Broadway, Pueblo, CO
You will be called upon to elect the following officers: Potentate, Chief Rabban, Assistant Rabban, High Priest and Prophet, Oriental Guide, Treasurer, Recorder and Representatives to the Imperial Council. To gain admission into this meeting, the Shriners International Bylaws require that a member must be in possession of and present his current year's membership card.
Shriners International Bylaws Election Regulations:
Shriners International Bylaws, paragraph 325.11, Election Regulations (a) Electioneering. A candidate for an elected office in a Shrine temple may print, publish and circulate during the year he is seeking the elected office, a resume consisting of his educational background, his vocational history, and his Masonic and Shrine record. Except as provided in the prior sentence, the printing, publication, circulating or distribution of resolutions, letters, telegrams, tickets, email or other devices, by a unit, club, Noble, or group of Nobles, suggesting, recommending, opposing, or containing the names of proposed candidates for office in the temple is prohibited. (b) Expenditures Prohibited. The expenditure of money for gifts, favors, or entertainment on behalf of a candidate for elected office is prohibited. (c) Violation. For any violation of (a) or (b), the Imperial Potentate may suspend any offending Noble, and he may declare the election of the officers void and order a new election. (d) Notice. At least one week prior to the annual meeting or any election, the temple Recorder shall mail to each member a notice thereof containing this section. Aleikum Es Selamu

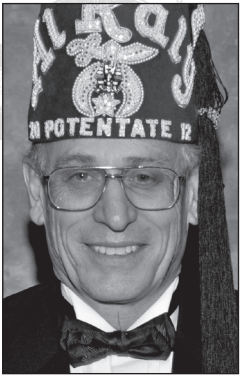

FEATURED SHRINER MARK GIFFIN

Mark was born in Kansas City, Missouri, to the late Donald and Caroline Giffin. His father, Donald, was an attorney and partner in the law firm of Spencer Fane Britt and Browne. He has three sibling, two brothers, Paul and Donald, Jr and Elizabeth who has passed away.

Mark started high school at the Abbey School in Canon City Colorado, then moved his sophomore year to the Barstow School in Kansas City MO. He graduated in the Class of 1981. He went on to graduate from The University of Kansas with a bachelors degree in Personnel Administration 1987.

His first jobs were mowing yards and being a bus boy in a restaurant. Other jobs included working as a Business Analyst and Customer Service Representative with DST Systems in Kansas City for 13 years. He also worked for the IRS as a tax examiner, sold insurance, managed a convenience store and managed a motel property. He thought about the military, but decided against it.

There are always funny things that happen along the way. One of the best Mark had was when his dad was representing a client who owned a motel named the Elm Cliff Motel in Kansas City. The owner needed a night manager for the motel and his dad recommended Mark. The motel rented rooms by the hour. Sometimes he would get calls from wives who thought their husbands were cheating on them. He would always say "I can neither confirm nor deny your husband is here but you



are more than welcome to drive through our parking lot."

Mark had and interesting, almost funny, experience on the job when he was managing a Circle-K in Kansas City. He was held up and robbed one evening (not funny). The person made the mistake of going down the street and holding up a 7-11 convenience store. Why was it a mistake? His ex-girlfriend was

working at the 7-11. So, Mark got to go in to a police line-up. He identified the robber by a tattoo he had on his right arm. During the line up, the officer told the line up to "step forward say your name is John Doe and that you are from Kansas City." When they got to the person who held him up, the officer said "step forward say your name is John Doe, you are from Kansas City. Also roll up your sleeves." He ended spending 10 years in prison.

Mark was raised as a Master Mason in 1989. He was drawn to the Masons because they all seemed to be men with good character and kept me out of trouble. He became a Shriner in 2019. Growing up in the Order of DeMolay they often had Shriners as Advisors. They always seemed to be having fun whether they were dressed as clowns working the local rodeo or parades. Becoming a Shriner just seemed natural.

Mark's family went on a vacation to London, England. He and his sister had just gotten finished seeing a show and were

walking back to their flat. Behind them, they heard "Elizabeth, Mark" and they turned around to see their Aunt in London England. What are the odds that you will run into a relative thousands of miles away from home in a city as large as London? After that he said he thought he had seen it all. Later on, he had moved out to Colorado Springs and was walking through a parking lot. A little voice inside his head told him to turn around. He turned around to see his very first girl friend who he hadn't seen in over 40 years. The first experience led him to believe the second experience did indeed happen.

Mark is a huge fan of the Kansas City Chiefs and the Kansas Jayhawks men's basketball team. The only obsession he has is his 6-year-old dog Boomer. Mark says Boomer is the most spoiled dog he knows. Boomer is a Labrador mix breed and is very friendly. Everywhere they go, Boomer is instantly the center of attention! In my opinion, Boomer isn't spoiled.... he is simply an amazing dog who receives the adoration he deserves! Mark enjoys hiking. He recently completed the Incline Trail. He also likes biking along the Santa Fe Trail.

He believes that everything happens for a reason. If it sounds too good to be true, chances are it is. His favorite sayings are "Don't look back – someone may be gaining on you." And

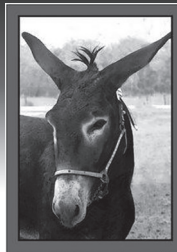
