Mike was born in Dupree, South Dakota where his father worked at the time. He returned to Colorado at the age of two weeks and has called Colorado home ever since. His mother is 95; he has one sister, a niece, nephew as well as a great niece and nephew.

Mike graduated high school in Ordway, Colorado and went on to the University of Southern Colorado. He had two majors, Accounting and Business Administration and two minors, English and Social Sciences.

Mike's hobbies include raising roses, walking, playing board games and bridge. He's involved in several activities including volunteering for Health Solutions, playing in the bell choir and singing in his church choir at Ascension Episcopal. He serves as the treasurer of Ascension Episcopal and volunteers for the outreach ministry of Laundry Love.

Mike made his first job a career, working as a supervisor of the business office for Crowley County including County Administration and Department of Human Services for 43 years. 


